#### Support for Burton Soup Kitchen



#### Healthy Eating Tips





Limit portion sizes. Don't insist your child cleans the plate, and never use food as a reward or bribe



Make healthy snacks available. Keep plenty of fruit, vegetables, and healthy beverages (water, milk, pure fruit juice) on hand so kids avoid unhealthy snacks like fizzy pop, crisps, and biscuits.



Disguise the taste of healthier foods. Add vegetables to a stew, for example, or mash carrots up with mashed potato, or add a sweet dip to slices of apple.



Attendance from 6th September 2017 to date: 95.18%. The School target is: 95%






