Children should arrive in school at normal time and should be collected at 3.05pm.

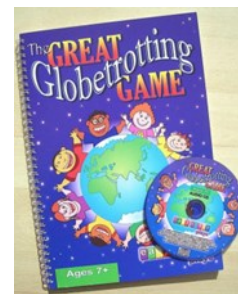
They should wear their school jumper or cardigan with sensible trousers/tracksuit bottoms and trainers. A packed lunch will be provided.

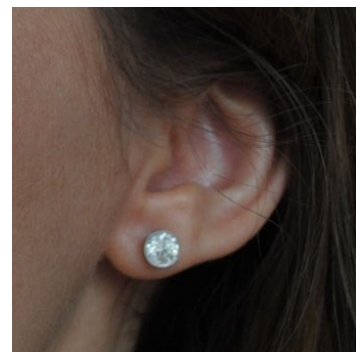
